

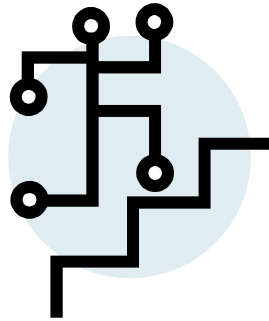
**A SUCCESSFUL

ACTIONS**

1. **Civilian Clothes:** Whether or not you are scheduled for a commercial flight, bring a complete set of civilian clothes with you to WTP. A limited selection of civilian clothes is available at the Camp Arifjan PX. Travel plans can change at the last minute. Civilian clothes, uniforms, or PT gear are all authorized for wear while you are at WTP.

2. **Separate your gear:** The gear drop process will go faster if you have already separated all your turn-in gear from your uniforms and personal gear and packed them in separate seabags.

3. **Contact Your Command:** Once you know the approximate date of your return, contact your Command to communicate any concerns, transportation, berthing or family needs.

4. **ECRC Newsletter:** The ECRC monthly newsletter is an invaluable resource for both you and your family during deployment. If you are not receiving an e-mail copy contact ECRC at: ecrc.hq.fct@navy.mil

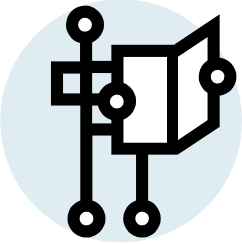

WARRIOR TRANSITION PROGRAM — PREPARING FOR YOUR RETURN HOME

AT YOUR DEPLOYMENT SITE



Planning your return is your responsibility!

1. 60-45 days out from your BOG date contact your in-country NAVCENT Forward Headquarters to obtain a **Warrior Transition Program Quota**.

Ensure your request date is at least ten days prior to your BOG date. Sailors

assigned in Kuwait should contact the Warrior Transition Program directly for your quota and coordination with Kuwait LNOs for follow on travel.

1. Prior to detaching from your deployment Command you must have a stamped and signed set of your **Transfer Orders (Demobilization Orders for Reservists)**, a **Theatre Release Letter** (signed by an 06), and copy of your **Travel Itinerary**.

2. Check your **Military ID Card**. Inform the WTP staff immediately upon arrival if your ID Card expires within 30 days of your BOG date.

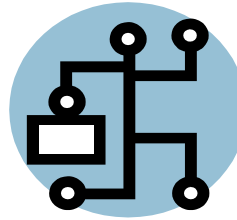
3. All Active Duty Sailors are required to complete the online portion of the **PDHA** no earlier than 30 days prior to reporting to WTC.

YOUR TIME AT WARRIOR TRANSITION PROGRAM

The Warrior Transition Program is located on Camp Arifjan, Kuwait. Immediately upon arrival at Camp Arifjan check in with the WTP staff for berthing assignment and schedule information. All sailors will expect to be berthed in tents during transition at WTP.

At WTP you will:

1. Day One: Gear Drop and Weapons Turn-in. Weapons must be cleaned to inspection standards and free of all oils prior to turn-in. Weapons can be cleaned at WTP the day prior to and the day of gear drop. Depending on class size and schedule, organized weapon cleaning times may be scheduled. Gear must be free of “pinchable dust.” You will also confirm completion of your electronic **PDHA**. After the gear drop you will attend an **Admin Brief** where you will get detailed information about the rest of the process.



You will complete several requirements prior to your departure.

2. Day Two: On Day Two you will attend the CNO mandated **Warrior Transition Workshop** to facilitate a positive beginning for the journey home. After the workshop you will be able to complete the US Fleet Forces post-IA survey as well as an internal WTP feedback survey.

3. Day Three: You will attend a mandatory **Travel Brief** in the morning to receive final instructions regarding the Rotator flight, weigh all your bags and be checked into the flight. You will have the rest of the day free until leaving for customs in the evening, depending on the flight time.

4. Day Four: The **Rotator flight** will normally depart theatre in the early morning, make a fuel stop somewhere in Europe, and arrive in Baltimore sometime that afternoon. Follow-on travel arrangements to your NMPS will be arranged by WTP.

Commercial Flights: If you are scheduled for a commercial flight your travel to the airport will be coordinated through the Warrior Transition Center. **Civilian clothes** are required for commercial flights; closed toe shoes, long pants, full length shirt w/sleeves (no military or provocative print).
